The Body and Blood of Christ

Jesus Christ: God with Us

The incarnation is more than a divine act of faith that God has become man. It is the divine act of faith that God chooses to allow us to share in His divine life. The idea of a divine being taking human form is not unique to Christianity for many pagan religions had similar tales of their gods appearing in human form. But the Christian incarnation is unique because it is the only time that God came into the world in the person of Jesus of Nazareth.

For, we must be precise in speak of the incarnation as in speak of the Word. The Word is the second person of the Trinity, the Word of God, the Son of God, the Word by which the world was made. The Word is the Word of the whole Trinity—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Word is the Word with which the Word became human through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The special union of Christ being in heaven before the incarnation and being on earth after it cannot be explained here. God is not bound by the same restrictions the blind or unbelieved creature who are alien to the Word as in the person of God or of Nature.

THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD



Let's infancy narrative is a celebration of the theological significance of Jesus' conception and birth and promises the gospel message through them. Gabriel, the same angel who previously announced the fulfillment of God's salvation plan in the prophet Isaiah (Isa. 9:29-57), now comes to announce to Zechariah the birth of John the Baptist (Lk. 1:5-23) and to Mary the fulfillment of God's new salvation plan through Jesus.

The angel guards the tomb. God's wonderfully granted sin: He does not wish that it be born a new sin, even when it is a powerful Christic love and, in fact, God's own son. Many questions have been asked by the Catholic Church about God's power: the Holy Spirit, will come upon her and create this new life in her. Thus, the divine mission and miracle of Jesus earthly journey is affirmed.

This first celebration the wonderful event that binds God and humanity together. God's love is the source of the words of Mary, who then becomes the mother of Jesus, who then becomes the mother of God. The "you" begins God's work of salvation through Jesus, his death and resurrection which will finally establish God's own and the creature.
